


Designing For The Future

Accommodation

Accommodation must be booked direct with the hotel - the Mercure Hotel (the conference venue) as well as the neighbouring Ibis Brisbane. Special delegate rates are as follows:

Mercure Brisbane - 85-87 North Quay

Rooms start at \$148.00 per room per night (based on single, double or twin occupancy). Rate is 'room only' and does not include breakfast. Breakfast is available for an additional \$20 per person.

Ibis Brisbane - 85-87 North Quay (interconnected with the Mercure)

Rooms start at \$118 per room per night (based on single, double or twin occupancy). Rate is 'room only' and does not include breakfast. Breakfast is available for an additional \$15 per person.

- Select the required Hotel noting we are at Mercure Brisbane (not King George Square) and Ibis Brisbane (not Elizabeth Street).
- Enter required dates and details and make your booking.

Alternatively, you can call booking support on 1300 65 65 65 quoting the details above.

Of course you may also book your own accommodation elsewhere in CBD Brisbane (where there is ample).

Cancellation Policy

A full refund, less a \$150 cancellation fee per registration, will be made on any cancellations received by Friday 23rd August 2019. No refunds will be issued for any registration cancellations made after August 23rd, although substitutions of delegates will be accepted. All cancellations must be made in writing to the conference coordinator.

Condition of Entry

It is a condition of entry that no delegate may disrupt the order of events or intent of the program. Anyone considered to be disturbing the program intent will be asked to leave. Only pamphlets and brochures approved by the event organisers may be distributed.
